She contributed to French major investments all over fuel cycle back-end, in La Hague as process engineer of UP3 Plutonium processing facility, in Melox MOX plant as deputy head of the waste management project and in Marcoule as project manager of various investments for liquid effluents treatment and preparation for shut-down of UP1 reprocessing plant.

In 1999, she was the first Program manager for UP1 Decommissioning operations.

After a short break from Decommissioning as Director of TNI for transportation of MOX and Plutonium in France and abroad, she joined the nuclear division of CEA in 2010, to drive the Department of D&D projects, on 5 sites (Marcoule, Cadarache, Grenoble, Saclay, Fontenay aux Roses).

She was then appointed Head of Program in charge of R&D for D&D and associated waste and she is now working at the headquarters of the new directorate dedicated to D&D, in charge of prospective and international development and collaborations.

She is also the French representative in the field of D&D and CEA representative at NEA as deputy head at the Management board of the Cooperative Program on Decommissioning.
